



VIDYA VIHAR COVID19 PROTOCOL AFTER REOPENING

- A single reporting date for a batch of students who are sent to 7-day room quarantine immediately into rooms having attached bathroom. 99 such rooms are available in Senior Boys Block of VVRS, 6 students can stay in each of the nine houses of the Junior and Middle Hostels of VVRS with their personal bathroom and toilet, 26 rooms with the attached bathroom are available in the Girls Block of VVRS, 68 students can be quarantined in VVIT.
- We will be accepting maximum 200 students in a batch. Classes 10,11 & 12 of VVRS will be called in the first phase. Reporting will be Voluntary. Online Classes will continue for others
- Students will bring their Mobile Phone with working SIM, Thermometer, Pulse Oxymeter, Face Shield, Washable Masks, Sanitizer, Handwash, Letter of Permission of Parent, Details of 3 Emergency Contact Nos., Full Shirt and Winter Clothes
- No student will be accepted without a Current COVID19 Test Report. Quarantine period may vary based on perceived reliability of a particular type of test

RT PCR – 7 days

TrueNAAT – 10 days

Rapid Antibody – 10 days

- We will ensure maximum spreading of students across all rooms available in the campus during and after quarantine period prioritising isolation of newly arrived batch of students
- Rooms with attached bathrooms will be prioritized for suspicious cases
- As far as possible, No Entry of outsiders will be allowed into the campus. We will try to manage with only resident staff and students.
- Classes will be conducted in largest teaching room available like Senior Chemistry Lab, Senior Physics Lab, Senior Library, Conference Hall, Junior Biology Lecture Theatre, Music Room, Library Floor Classroom or even in open, if possible
- Cleaning of Room and classroom will be done every day.
- Spitting, disposing wastes, garbage in the room and campus outside bins will be strictly prohibited.
- Washing hands, Social distancing, wearing face masks and other hygiene procedures will be practiced mandatorily by all the residents of the hostel.



- Adequate social distance will be maintained and queue system will be followed in Mess with half the students accommodated in Junior Mess and another half in Senior Mess
- Every student will need to confine themselves to their allotted room and not to venture into others room and will not be allowed to roam around the institute Campus unnecessarily.
- On any symptoms of ill health students will contact the hostel authorities immediately.
- They can consult the medical team at the dispensary for any health-related issues and in case of health emergencies, hospital ambulance will be arranged at a very short notice.

- In suspicious / confirmed COVID19 cases, Parents will be contacted on the emergency numbers provided and the student will be handed over to their care. They are expected to reach as soon as possible on receiving information from the Institution Medical Team.
 - Students will not be allowed to leave the campus before end of session.
 - Outside food is not allowed into the college campus, food provided by the hostel authorities only will be allowed to be consumed in the designated mess area (Or personal room during quarantine)
 - Body temperature will be monitored frequently and hand sanitizers will be provided in every block of the hostel and mess
 - Students breaking protocol will be sent back to their homes.
 - Faculty and Staff are also expected to follow the same quarantine and safety rules
